The Puget Sound Region will be offering the 5th annual Regional High Performance Camp in the summer of 2009. The program is modeled after the National USA Volleyball High Performance Program which is aimed at identifying and training the elite junior volleyball players in the country.

The mission of the Puget Sound Regional High Performance Program is threefold. The first is to provide an elite training setting for the top junior volleyball players in the region. The second is to help develop the level of competency within the coaching ranks in the region. Finally, the program will strive to introduce USAV play to young athletes not yet familiar with junior club volleyball.

Youth Team Will Travel Again This Year!!

In the summer of 2007 the Puget Sound Region Youth Team competed at The Global Challenge in Utah, coming home with the Gold Medal. Last year, our Youth Team competed at the USAV HP Championships in Tucson, Arizona and finished 5th out of 16 teams in the National Youth Division.

Once again, we will be selecting a team from the Youth camp to represent the Puget Sound Region at the 2009 USAV HP Championships. This year we will be entering the International Youth Division which will provide us with competition against USAV nationally trained teams as well as a potential to see international competition. The tournament will be held in Ft. Lauderdale, Florida from July 22nd through July 26th (travel dates will be July 21st and July 26th).

The actual cost of the trip will be listed once we finalize all the travel details. Last year's travel costs were \$500 per player and we expect the costs to be similar this year. This amount covered ALL costs, including airfare, team entry fee, uniforms, hotel and food.

At this time, if you are registering for tryouts for the Youth division, please let us know if you can travel and compete at the HP Championships. There is an area on the tryout form asking about the player's availability. You will not be binding yourself to the trip by stating yes - however, it will give us an idea of our ability to field a travel squad.
